- Troop 80 is hosting your Pack derby and providing a race venue and results. You are welcome to have a post-race celebration to award your Pack supplied trophies and or ribbons etc. Your Packs participation is a qualifier for the Troop 80 City Wide Derby. Pack derby entry fees cover your eligible City-Wide participants (no extra fees are required for the City-Wide race). Troop 80 will provide championship trophies for the City-Wide race only.
- Cost: \$5.00 Per car entered no maximum per Pack.
 - \$2.50/Car for track management
 - \$2.50/Car for Expenses

 - Pack Roster
As complete as possible for pre-race computer entry, can be complete Pack membership list, (it's easier to remove names race day than to add them).
 - Specific car information if know ahead of time for entering data prior to race day.

 - b. Den (Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelo, Arrow of light, Open)
 - c. Scout Name
- Check-in
 - Car ID
 - Each Car to be marked with a Numbered Sticky dot This marking will be linked to the following given at check-in:
 - Pack #
 - Den (Tiger, Wolf, Bear, Webelo, Arrow of light, Open)
 - Scout Name
 - Car Inspection
 - Each car will be checked to insure it meets race regulations
 - Weight
 - Size
 - Wheel Clearance
 - Tweaking
 - Adjustment of cars will be limited to time allotted for check-in

- Date: January 28th (Saturday)
- Cars will be raced in Den's and Pack groups
- Cars will be race three times (once in each lane)
- Times will be recorded
- An attempt will be made to video and recorded each Pack race and the City Wide.
- Times for each Pack's cars will be recorded and sorted per Den and overall Pack
- Race results will be printed and given to each Pack.
- If a car is damaged during a race and cannot safely run, an attempt may be made by the car's owner or Pack representative to repair the car in a timely manner so that it can complete the race (see race rules).
- The top 5 fastest car from each Pack and the fastest car from each Den and Open will be invited to participate in the City-Wide Race to be held later the evening of January 28th.
- Cars eligible for the City-wide can be taken after the individual Pack races and brought back to the City-wide race. Tweaking is permitted so long as the car meets check-in requirements prior to City-wide race.
- Beauty Contest (Pack Races)
If requested Troop 80 Scouts will Judge and list the top 3 Best Looking Cars of a Pack for bragging rights.
- Grudge Match Races
Before the City-wide official race an open grudge match will be held. Each entry will be given 3 tickets and will offer up one ticket per grudge race. The winner of each race will collect the tickets offered up for that race. The Match ends win one participant holds all tickets or no one is left to race.
- Splinter Wood
After the City-Wide race is completed a Splinter Wood crash up derby will be held. This event will damage cars and the winner will be determined by Troop 80 leadership judging the least damaged car.
- Video
 - An attempt will be made to video record each race and make it available to the Packs. It may be edited for time and a final recording made of each Pack and the City-wide race. This is a time consuming process and dependent upon the personnel and equipment availability.
